**Superkingdom, Kent**  
Architect: Consarc Architects  
Cost: £20,000

In collaboration with arts organisation London Fieldworks, Consarc has designed three installations providing shelter for a number of animal species, which sit in three ancient trees in King's Wood, Kent. Despotic architecture was used as a reference for these 'palaces' in the trees, particularly the dominant characteristics of buildings associated with Mussolini, Stalin and Ceausescu. The result is three unique structures consisting of water-catchers, bird boxes and moss-growing crevasses.
